Project Description*	This educational initiative aims to develop a pioneering & replicable school-based learning model founded on Lantau's Fung Shui Woods (FSW) for eventual future adoption in all Lantau schools. The ultimate purpose is to stimulate a deep- rooted mindset change in schools bringing about the realisation that climate change and sustainable lifestyles are key challenges facing us all and that schools can make a difference. The Model extends findings from a current FSW study1 (LCF/EE/2021/6) thereby enlarging practical use of the research. Its unique & innovative educational methodology is predicated on inquiry-based learning – Exploration, Engagement and Experiential teaching and learning achieved through a tried & tested creative learning system that is cross-curriculum and therefore incorporates STEAM education. There are three interrelated components: Part A: Establishment of an Ecological Garden based on the vegetation structure and plant composition of a Lantau FSW in the school grounds of a Lantau pilot school. Part B: Extensive cross-curriculum educational package specifically designed to disseminate year-round learning opportunities.
