Project Title	Land.Tao: Fung Shui Woods School Learning Model for Nature-based Solutions
Project Description*	<p>This educational initiative aims to develop a pioneering & replicable school-based learning model founded on Lantau's Fung Shui Woods (FSW) for eventual future adoption in all Lantau schools.</p> <p>The ultimate purpose is to stimulate a deep-rooted mindset change in schools bringing about the realisation that climate change and sustainable lifestyles are key challenges facing us all and that schools can make a difference.</p> <p>The Model extends findings from a current FSW study¹ (LCF/EE/2021/6) thereby enlarging practical use of the research.</p> <p>Its unique & innovative educational methodology is predicated on inquiry-based learning – Exploration, Engagement and Experiential teaching and learning achieved through a tried & tested creative learning system that is cross-curriculum and therefore incorporates STEAM education.</p> <p>There are three interrelated components:</p> <p>Part A: Establishment of an Ecological Garden based on the vegetation structure and plant composition of a Lantau FSW in the school grounds of a Lantau pilot school.</p> <p>Part B: Extensive cross-curriculum educational package specifically designed to disseminate year-round learning opportunities.</p>

	Part C: Documentary for territory-wide dissemination to capture key phases in the Model from inception to completion, illustrating the process of creating the learning programme and the related Ecological Garden's development.
