During the Ming and Qing Dynasties, Lantau was an important military strategic location in China, coastal defense facilities such as Fan Lau Fort, Tung Chung Walled City, Tung Chung Fort and Tung Chung Battery are important medium to understand the history and culture of that period of time. By using different types of onsite, offsite and media-based programmes, including field trips with photography and sketch, site-specific augmented reality, checkpoint audio stories, animation, board game with 3D cardboard models, etc., this project aims to deepen the participant's understanding of the location, design, construction and operation of coastal defense facilities, so as to make the public more understand the important role Lantau had played in modern China and the close relationship between Lantau and China.
